Brian Sherman is heavily involved in numerous charitable projects in Australia and is a major contributor specifically to arts, education and environmental institutions, as well as numerous Australian and Jewish charities. In 2004, Brian was awarded the Order of Australia for service to the community as a philanthropist and benefactor to a range of arts, education, and sporting organizations, and to business and commerce. In 2006, Brian received the Champion of Entrepreneurship award for the Eastern Region in the Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year awards. On 1 January 2001, Brian was appointed as President of the Board of Trustees of the Australian Museum. He is also a Director of the Australian Museum Foundation and co-director and patron of Voiceless - The Animal Protection Institute - founded by the Sherman Family in 2004. Brian was Director of Australia's Channel Ten for some sixteen years, and executive producer of an international award-winning documentary movie, *Uncle Chatzkel*. He was a director of the Sydney Olympic Games (SOCOG) and Chair of Finance. Brian is Director of Australia/Israel & Jewish Affairs Council (AIJAC) and holds senior positions in a number of other Jewish and Australian organizations.
